

Sandy Spring Monthly Meeting House

Project Description

Oyster, Imus, Petzold and Associates is preparing the preliminary plan for subdivision of 3 separate parcels that make up the grounds of the Sandy Spring Monthly Meeting House in Sandy Spring, Maryland. An approved preliminary plan is required prior to the phased development of the Sandy Spring Monthly Meeting House Religious Education Campus. The developed project will include the following elements: (1) a new Religious Education Building, (2) the removal of the non-historic additions built to the historic Lyceum building, (3) the construction of a new addition to the Lyceum, (4) the construction of a new Community House and (4) a pervious driveway service entrance, (5) an outdoor dining patio to be built adjacent to the Lyceum, (6) a play ground and (7) a new entrance from Route 108 to the Religious Education Building.

Additional work required for the completion of this project include the Natural Resources Inventory / Forest Stand Delineation, the Forest Conservation Plan, the Site Plan and Record Plat, the Site Development Plan, and the stormwater management (SWM) concept and final plan.

The site work includes an entrance and driveway from Route 108 (Olney - Sandy Spring Road), SWM, site utilities, and a playground. These elements will be integrated into the historic context of the site.

The 8 acre site includes a historic Lyceum and the historic meeting house.
